This guide describes how to install and activate MagiCAD.

You may need this guide when using MagiCAD for the first time or when setting up a new computer.

| Step | Description | Navigation |

| Download MagiCAD | Go to the MagiCAD portal and find the download section | <p>https://portal.magicad.com</p>  |
| Prepare download | <p>Select "Autodesk Revit" under "Technology".</p> <p>Click "Sign in to download".</p> |  |
| Sign in and start download | <p>Sign in using activation ID: <i>Act-901a1df6-79be-45e4-ba61-325e9d6fcddb-0</i></p> <p>Start download of the installation file.</p> |  |
| Install MagiCAD | <p>Extract the zip file (located in "Downloads").</p> <p>When opening the downloaded file, you will see a message asking you to extract the files.</p> <p>Click "Extract all".</p> <p>Then open the installation file (exe) to start the installation.</p> |  |

| <p>Complete installation</p> | <p>Follow the installation guide:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accept the license terms • Choose default settings (select the recommended options) • Continue until the installation is complete |  |
| <p>Open License Management</p> | <p>Open the MagiCAD License Management Utility from the Start menu.</p> |  |
| <p>Set up license server</p> | <p>Go to “Stand Alone Licenses” and click “Options...”</p> <p>Select “Use network licenses” and enter the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Server: 2800@magicad.ait.dtu.dk • Port: 2194 • Click “Test connections” • Click “Save” when all tests are successful |  |
| <p>Borrow a license (optional)</p> | <p>Use this if you need to work offline</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go to “Network Licenses” • Select a “borrowable subscription” • Click “Borrow” • Choose a period (e.g. 30 days) |  |
| <p>Check installation</p> | <p>Open Revit and verify that MagiCAD is available and working.</p> <p>In Revit: look for the “MagiCAD” tab.</p> |  |
