

Who is eligible for SPS?



Students with a documentet (chronic) functional impairment

General terms for receiving SPS:

- Danish citizen
- EU or EEA Citizen
- Rank alongside a Danish citizen



Documentation requirements




- Your name and date must be clearly stated.
- Medical documentation, e.g.:
 - ✓ Doctor's certificate
 - √ Psychiatrist
 - √ Specialist doctor
 - ✓ Medical record printout
 - ✓ Printout from Sundhed.dk
- Test for dyslexia or dyscalculia

Note:

- ✓ It is your responsibility to obtain the medical documentation – DTU does not cover any potential costs.
- ✓ We can only apply for SPS on your behalf once you have received your Danish personal identification number.



Where does SPS apply?



SPS must only be applied for at DTU




If you take courses at institutions other than DTU, it is the SPS unit at DTU that helps establish SPS at the other educational institution.

- This applies:
- If DTU is the enrollment university for a joint programme
- If you take courses at other educational institutions
- If you are going on an exchange abroad




Deadlines and case processing



- No deadlines to apply for SPS
- Total case processing time: 1–6 weeks
- The SPS unit is bound by confidentiality
 - Your lecturers are not informed
 - It does not appear on your diploma









Examination conditions

Here you can apply for special exam conditions. To be granted this, medical documentation or a dyslexia/dyscalculia assessment is required. Read more about special examination conditions at student.dtu.dk.

- April 15 for the summer exam
- July 1 for the re-examination period in August


If you do not wish to apply for or have already been granted special examination conditions for the remainder of your enrollment, you should proceed to the next step regarding the SPS application.



















The further SPS application process





Good advice for SPS students

→ You are not alone!

10% of all students at DTU are receiving SPS.

→ Be open about your needs!

Share with your supporters and possibly your teachers and fellow students what you need – this gives them the opportunity to support you better.

★ Well-being is a necessity for learning!

Use the support DTU offers (SPS, study guidance, special exam conditions, etc.).

→ Remember your strengths!

Special needs say nothing about your academic abilities – only about your learning conditions. Use the support as a resource to bring your skills into play, not as a sign of weakness.
